# 2024 Queen City Handicap Tournament Rules

1. The following rules plus the USBC rules will govern all participants of this tournament.

2. Rule 319A. Entrants will use their highest 2022-2023 sanctioned league average based on 21 or more games. Bowlers without a 2022-2023 average will use their 2023-2024 winter league average based on 21 or more games as of June 1, 2024 If a bowler does not have either average a 2023 summer average based on 21 or more games will be accepted. All others will bowl scratch. The 10 pin rule is in effect.

3. All bowlers will be required to initial averages as printed on recap as correct prior to bowling their second game. (It shall be the bowler's responsibility to verify his or her own average). Failure to use proper average or make corrections prior to bowling second game shall result in disqualification if the submitted

average is below the correct average. Or base prize winning on submitted average if higher.

4. **USBC Rule 319 D** is in effect. Any bowler, who qualified for a prize of \$300 or more in any event in a tournament which has ended within the previous 12 month period even if payment or prizes has not been made, must report actual score, position, and amount won for possible rerating. Tournament management reserve the right to rerate the average of any bowler whose entering average does not reflect the bowler's true ability. A bowler must report if he/she had an actual accumulate average in 21 or more games of tournament played in the pervious 12 months that exceeded the entering average by 15 pins or more.

- 5. Rule 315. Re-entry in any of the events will be allowed, however the bowlers first doubles and singles events must be completed before re-entry into either doubles or singles. No more than two bowlers on the same team may place more than once. The same doubles partners may only place once. Only the highest singles score may place. All events will be the scores bowled on the first of each event and must be paid for prior to bowling in any event.
- 6. Handicap will be based on 80% of 220 for all bowlers with a minimum average of 135 being used and a maximum handicap of 204 pins per event.
- 7. Reserved entries close Midnight June 24 (postmarked) and will be given time preference. All others are subject to lane **AVAILABILITY**. Walk-in entries will close 30 minutes prior to each shift. No exceptions.
- 8. Automatic scoring will be the official scores and will be downloaded directly to computer. Any error must be reported within 24 hours.
- 9. All protests must be made to the tournament board in writing (see USBC rule 329). The tournament management reserves the right to accept or reject any and all entries and will resolve any disputes based on tournament and USBC rules.
- 10. No entry will be accepted without total entry fees (including fees for vacancy bowler) No refunds will be given once the entry has been received and scheduled to bowl.
- 11. This tournament is open to all men and women members of the USBC. Any non-member of the USBC may purchase membership prior to bowling for \$25.00.
- 12. Substitutions will be permitted upon notifications to a tournament board member within 30 minutes of the scheduled shift. An All Event entry may be transferred as long as neither party involved has bowled a single frame in the tournament.
- 13. Proper attire shall be worn at all times while competing. Approved attire includes: Shirts with sleeves, slack, dress jeans, dress shorts and dress skirts. The following are not allowed: tank tops, cut off denim short, cutoffs, short-shorts, swimsuits, spandex, athletic shorts, t-shirts or hats with obscenity. All issues with regard to proper attire will be decided upon by tournament management.
- 14. Prize money will be distributed at a ratio of at least one (1) for every seven (7) entries for each event.
- 15. The tournament board has the right to add dates and times as deemed necessary with approval of Depot Family Fun Center and the USBC.
